Christian Employers Alliance Urges SCOTUS to Strip Power from Unconfirmed Bureaucrats

Washington, D.C. — The following quote may be attributed to Christian Employers Alliance (CEA) President Margaret Iuculano, regarding a friend-of-the-court brief Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) attorneys filed on its behalf on March 27th with the U.S. Supreme Court in *Kennedy v. Braidwood Management, Inc.* In the brief, CEA is urging the Court to deem powerless bureaucrats dictating policies and regulations who have not been confirmed by the Senate.
