CEA Launches Center for Biblical Business, Scorecard to Protect 5 Workplace Freedoms

*New ‘Biblical Business Index’ Will Place Obedience to God Before
Partisan Pandering, Christian Employers Alliance Chief Says*

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Today the [Christian Employers Alliance \(CEA\)](#) announced the launch of its **Center for Biblical Business**, a landmark initiative designed to empower Christian business leaders with policy tools and biblical frameworks for today’s complex economic environment.

CEA President Margaret Iuculano says the Center for Biblical Business addresses a critical need for faith-based companies navigating today’s regulatory landscape.

“Christian employers have had to cobble together legal advice, regulatory updates, and faith-based guidance from scattered sources,” stated Iuculano. **“The Center for Biblical Business changes that by providing a one-stop policy shop where business owners can clearly see how legislation affects both their bottom line and their beliefs.”**

The new initiative features an exclusive partnership with The Institute for Legislative Analysis. The partnership enhances CEA’s analysis and interpretation of policy data through biblical principles — a long-standing trademark of CEA’s value to members and policymakers.

The Center for Biblical Business will evaluate legislation through five core biblical freedoms: First Freedoms (protecting religious expression), Workforce Freedom (allowing faith-aligned hiring policies), Economic Freedom (reducing regulations), Operational Freedom (safeguarding against crime and legal threats), and Health Care Freedom (enabling values-based health plans).

Iuculano says the Center’s **Biblical Business Index** will place obedience to God before partisan pandering.

“Unlike traditional scorecards influenced by partisan ideology, this index is anchored entirely in Scripture, with each vote, bill, and stance evaluated by its fidelity to biblical principles,” Iuculano said.

CEA will release the Scripture-based Biblical Business Index at the end of each legislative session.

The launch of the Center for Biblical Business comes as Christian employers see renewed hope with the return of President Trump to the White House and Speaker Mike Johnson in Congress, offering an opportunity to realign business policy with biblical principles — which promote human flourishing — after years of economic uncertainty and ideological challenges under the previous administration.
